

CHESOPEIAN COLONY CIVIC LEAGUE MEETING

APRIL 26, 2006

The meeting was called to order by the President, Linda Hill, at 7:45 P.M. 32 Colony residents were present (see attached list). Linda announced that a guest speaker, Jim Wood, member of the City Council and running for re-election in May was due to speak.

The Secretary's report was read and approved.

B.J. Taylor presented the Treasurer's report. (See attached Treasurer's Report). The Civic League exceeded over the budget in 2005; therefore, the board had voted to increase the dues by \$10 from \$40 to \$50. This was considered minor compared to other neighborhoods that do not offer as much as the Chesapeake Colony Civic League – i.e. Maintenance of entrance, fencing, and signs; 4th of July and Halloween parties; scholarship fund. Approximately \$200 was spent on the 4th of July Party in 2005 that everyone agreed was great and worth the money.

There is \$500 in an account for future renovation of boat ramp. The board is still trying to get Wayne McLesky to assist for the ramp. There also in money in the savings account for repair of the fences that border the businesses.

Out of 265 families, in 2003 194 families paid dues; 2004 -201; 2006 – 201.

Bill Thesier made a motion to approve the budget, and Marny Keogh seconded it. It was approved.

OLD BUSINESS

Carolyn Ditrack was thanked for her efforts as chairman of the *Welcoming Committee* in keeping up with new residents.

Marnie Keogh, *Security Captain*, reported that residents should be on the lookout in the spring for gypsies coming around for solicitation. You must have a permit from the city to solicit. Please call 911 or 427-5000 if you see anyone who is suspicious. She warned residents to be careful of children and strangers following them, citing the murder of the teenage girl in Kings Grant last year. There is a need for new block captains and she asked for volunteers. There is only one meeting a year.

NEW BUSINESS

Rolly Doan brought up the ongoing problem of Speeding in the colony and the problem of dogs being walked and the owners not *cleaning up the dog messes*. It was suggested that the residents be reminded to please carry bags with them. In reference to *speeding*, several suggestions were brought up such as speed bumps, signs, etc. B.J. made a motion for the board to take up the issue of speeding; it was seconded by Marnie Keough. The motion passed.

It was announced that McLesky is to put up a fence at the back of the new strip of stores that is to be built on Virginia Beach Blvd along side of current Lynnhaven convenience shops owned by McLesky that are adjacent to the entrance to the Colony.
