The most inviting post-Christmas items are auto navigation GPS systems (Garmin, Tom Tom, Magellan, etc.). These displays are frequently left in plain view, and have good resale potential. Leaving a parked car unlocked is equivalent to issuing an invitation to a theft. If a car contains a remote garage door opener, it might also provide a thief with access to the garage and home.
